**PCT Membership:** All actors cast are required to join PCT. A one-time membership fee of \$10 for an individual or \$20 for a family membership is due at the first rehearsal for new members. To maintain an active membership, you need only help out with one production per season in some way. For returning members, as long as your membership is current, (you participated last season) this fee is not required.

**Set / Prop / Costume Workshop Participation:** PCT is a community theatre and it takes everyone's help to make the magic happen. The cast is required to participate in set construction/painting, prop or costume workshops depending on individual skills (some prefer to build or paint, others are crafty, while others sew). We require a minimum of **10 hours** from each cast member. Special considerations will be handled on a case per case basis but there is always something people can do at a workshop or at home.

Failure to complete this requirement results in forfeiture of your complementary tickets. Important: All cast and crew are required to assist with load-in and strike. Time spent for load-in and strike does not count towards the minimum 10 hours.

**Costumes:** At the first rehearsal, we will get your measurements and clothing sizes. If you have any appropriate costume pieces, work with the costume manager to get clothing approved.

**Note:** Undergarments and personal items such as nylons, slippers, etc. are the responsibility of the actor. We recommend that you wear appropriate undergarments for modesty if you are uncomfortable changing with others and for quick changes if necessary behind the set.

**Tickets:** Tickets can be purchased through the VenueTech box office at the California Theatre or online. Each cast and crew member receives one complimentary ticket for the show, and can earn a second one after participation hours are completed. Comp tickets can be reserved starting 10/3/17 via phone or in person and they **must be reserved or picked up before opening night for opening weekend and by Friday night of closing weekend for closing weekend.**

**DVDs: (optional).** PCT video tapes each show and produces a DVD. This is a great keepsake for you. The cost is \$25.00 + \$5.00 S&H.

**Script Deposit:** There is a script deposit of \$30 required (This must be cash only). This deposit will be returned after your script has been returned in good condition.
