

MEET THE DIRECTOR



It has been an absolute pleasure directing *The Sunshine Boys* and to work this amazing cast and crew. Directing a play is such a delight and this troupe made my job easy.

Easy. That is until this week. I write this note the day before we open and I must say the term "Hell Week," as applied to the tech week leading up to opening, has taken on a whole new meaning.

The PTC warehouse was destroyed by fire the day we were scheduled to load the set into the theatre. We were at the warehouse the morning of the fire, but we could not gain full

access to the warehouse due to a non-functioning gate. We did manage to maneuver some flats through a small gap, but the gap was much too narrow to allow us to move any furniture, set pieces, or sound equipment. Satisfied that we could at least build the set, we planned to return the next day to move the remaining items after the City had repaired the gate. However, that afternoon, the alarm company notified us that the smoke alarm was activated. The warehouse is a total loss. When a reporter asked me later in the day if we would still open our show this week, my immediate reply was "Of course, the show must go on!" There was no question about it. So here we are.

The cast and crew, other theatre companies, and friends rallied to our side, and by Wednesday the last set piece was delivered and the last curtain was hung. With the support of our amazing community of friends, *The Sunshine Boys* would open on schedule, as if nothing had happened.

To say I am proud of this show is an understatement. I am not just proud of the production, but what it represents. No matter what obstacles we encountered, we persevered. I am indebted to all those who stepped up to help. I know I would miss someone if I tried to name them all, so please know how much I appreciate all of you!

This is not the typical directors note where I would have told you more about the show. The fact is, I felt as if I was watching Grumpy Old Men half the time. I would tell you how much I enjoyed the bantering between our characters. Kevin Burns and George Doerr who are an amazing comedy team. It feels as though Kevin and George are reprising their Odd Couple roles to some degree, and when you throw Michael Wilson into this mix, it's comedy gold! I appreciate our entire cast and the work they put into creating memorable moments. I also appreciate the supporting members of the cast who were so generous to share their time for their individual scenes. Thank you all!

To our patrons, thank you for coming and support PTC. I hope you enjoy our show and come back to enjoy our youth workshop of Honk Jr. in July.
